ORDER

The present revision was filed before this Commission on the complaint of Shri Sham Sundar Goel dated 23/11/2015/24/11/2015 regarding removal of solid waste from the park and roads of Ambala Market, Ambala City. After receiving the revision, notice U/S 17(1)(a) of the Haryana Right To Service Act was issued to the Joint Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ambala City and Executive Engineer, Municipal Corporation Ambala City by the Registrar, Haryana Right to Service Commission on 3.5.2016. The revision was received in this office on 18.4.2016 and in the notice, the parties were directed to appear before the Bench on at 11.00 a.m. on 24.5.2016. On 24.5.2016, the complainant was present but neither respondents in person nor his authorized agents were present before the Commission. The case was adjourned to 30.5.2016, again notice was issued to the parties. On 30.5.2016 Shri Gagandeep Singh, Joint Commissioner-cum- 2nd Grievances Redressal Authority, Municipal Corporation, Ambala City appeared

before the Commission and he was advised to call the complainant in person in his office and listen his grievances as alleged in complaint. The case was adjourned to 17.6.2016. On 17.6.2016, the complainant and respondents appeared before the Commission. Statement of complainant was recorded separately wherein he stated that respondents has complied with the directions dated 30.5.2016 and about 20 trolleys full of solid waste was removed from the market and he further stated that now he has no grievances against the respondents i.e. the Municipal Corporation. The complainant is satisfied with the respondents. No further orders needed and the revision is disposed off.
